Best Optimization produces less than 15% of population in at least one grade level
 All others Optimized between 18% and 15% of population using average class size 1/6th per grade

1. Select the number of classroom you have at your particular school.
2. Go across to see the Optimized configuration based as closely as possible on an even distribution per grade level.
2. Capacity includes a general notion of when Self-Contained classrooms are warranted (exceed as required locally)
2. In bold is the highest capacity for that school based on the even distribution.
2. No PK is included (add for PK as required locally)
3. Includes the average class size and the greatest capacity that can be reached before one class exceeds capacity.
4. 2017 Capacity and Capacity Loss over entire school.
5. Percentage of total capacity when any grade level exceeds individual class size for the first time.
6. Lowest Capacity at which waiver or additional classroom space will first be needed.

The numbers and distribution of classrooms is based on an even distribution of students per grade level. Larger and smaller class sizes will require the rooms to be reassigned to different grade levels and will adjust the overall capacity of the school. However, based on historical data, Kindergarten class sizes are larger than upper grade levels and when possible, this has been taken into consideration in developing student population per grade level.
